What is OnePortal?

OnePortal is a new parent portal which will enable you to access your child(ren)'s student information and systems, via a single dashboard.

Rather than juggling multiple logins, passwords and systems, OnePortal will merge a range of information from Engage, Canvas and other platforms into a single place.

It does not replace Engage or Canvas, but allows you to view your child(ren)'s information such as timetables, teachers, canvas submissions, feedback and school calendar from the same application.

There is a feedback button within OnePortal called "Rate this App" that you can share your experience and feedback with OSG.

What do I need to do?

How do I get access?

- Initial registration and access will be via an email coming shortly to your Engage registered email address.
- It will contain a link to OnePortal where you will use your **Engage email address to access**. You will also be requested to set a password for OnePortal as part of this process.
- If both Parents share the same email, only 1 account will be possible to create. In this instance, if you wish to have your own, you will need to contact your local campus to update Engage with a unique email address.

Will this change how I access other applications?

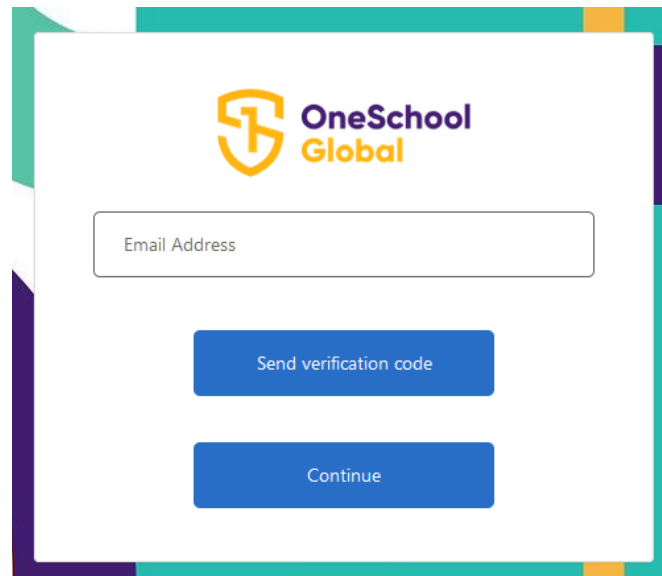
- This does not replace any current password to Engage, Canvas or other applications. We will be working to bring those system passwords together over time where possible. Allowing the same email and password across as many systems as possible.

Initial access via email

To setup your OnePortal access, you will receive an email welcoming you to OnePortal that will also contain a link to setup your access.

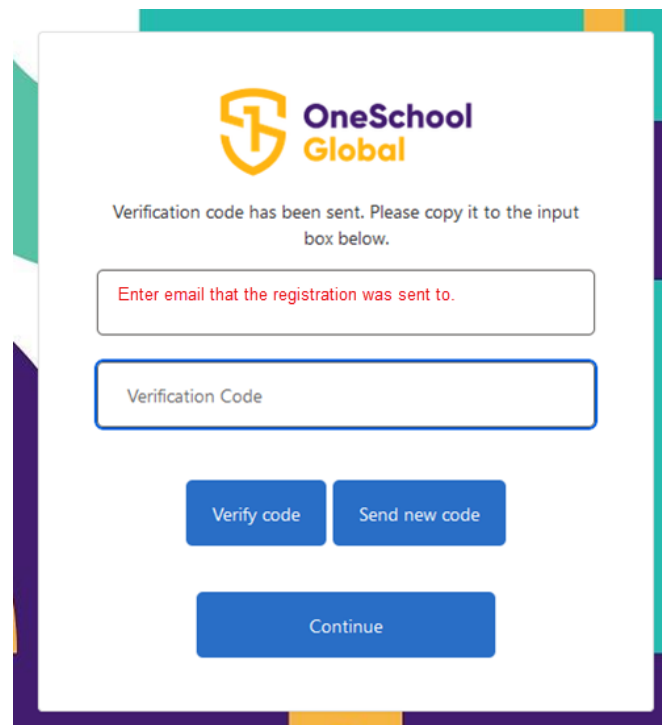
The setup process will then require the following:

1. Enter your **Engage email address** and select "Send verification code".



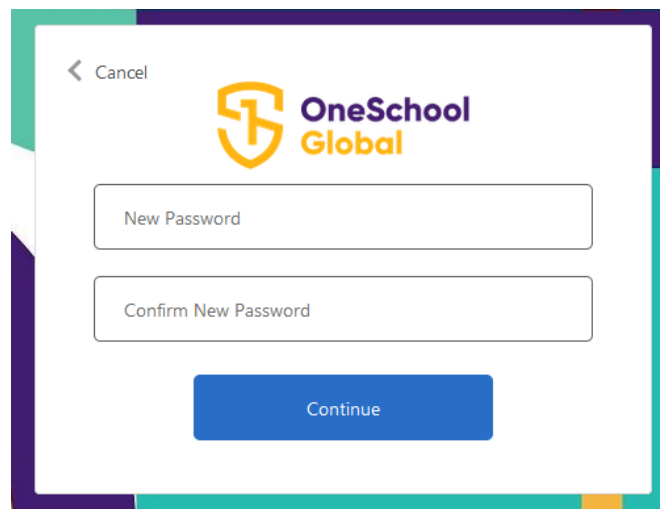

2. A verification code will be sent to that email.
3. Using that code, then enter your email address and the code into the next screen.



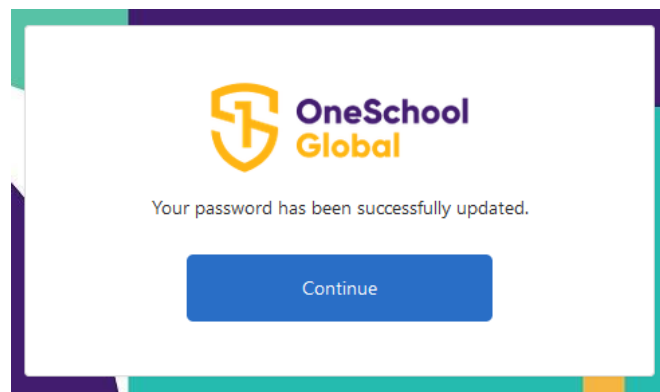

4. Your password set will then be confirmed, and your access is now completed



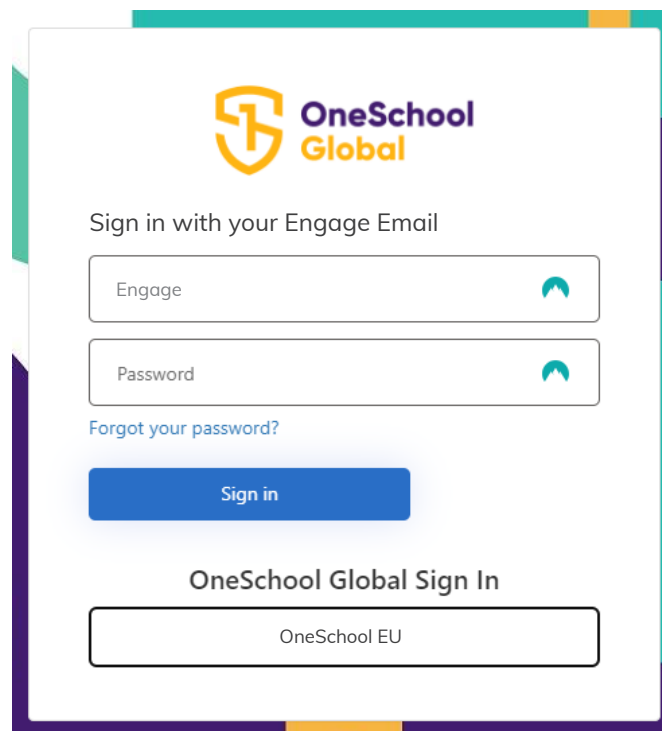

How do I access OnePortal –

Web browser

The application can be accessed from a computer via the Web browser at the following address <https://oneportaleu.oneschoolglobal.com>. This will be emailed to you. Please bookmark this site in your browser for future access.

- You will be presented with the OnePortal sign on page.
- Sign in with your **Engage Email** and your set password for OnePortal.
- **Note:** If you have a OneSchool Global volunteer account, you do not use that for this system.

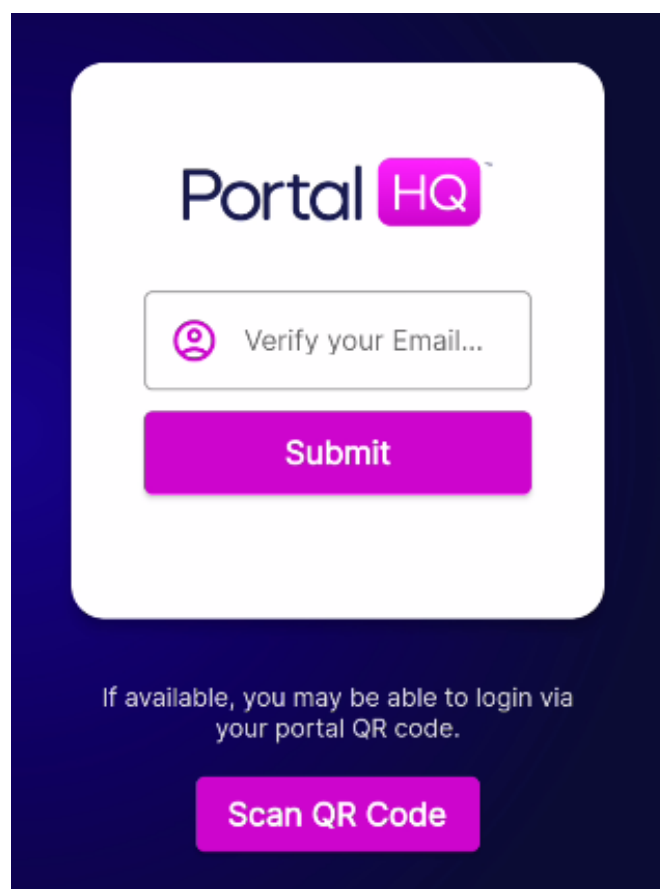

How do I access OnePortal – Mobile app

There is a mobile app to access OnePortal which is called “PortalHQ”. You can download this to your device from the device's app store by searching for “PortalHQ”.

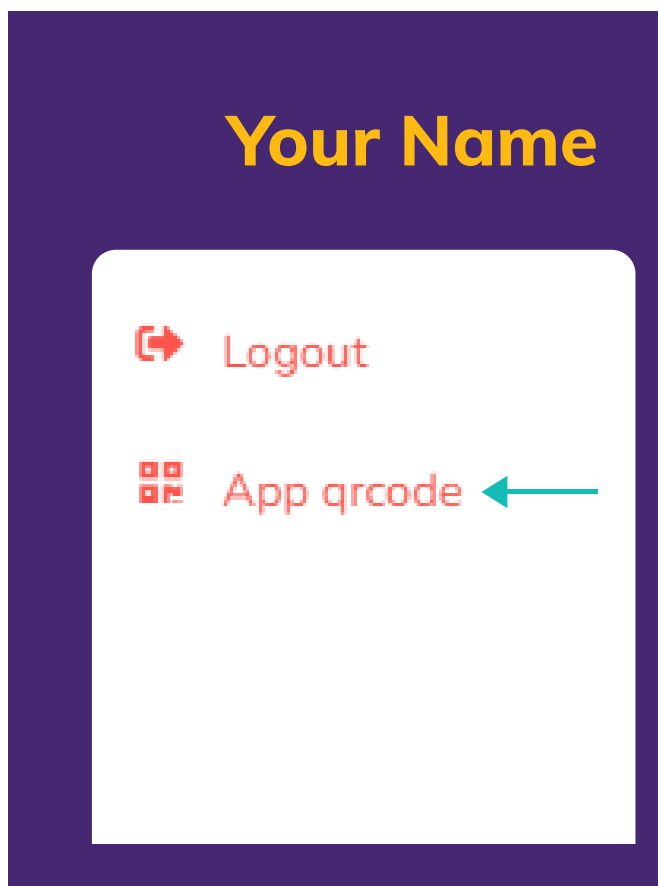
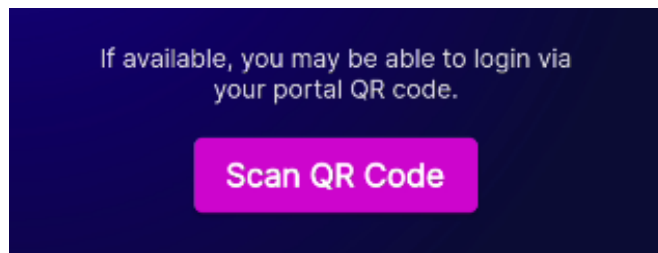
It is possible it will require streamline approval by your streamline household\business administrator.

To login to your OnePortal through the mobile app, you are going to use a QR code generated from the OnePortal website.



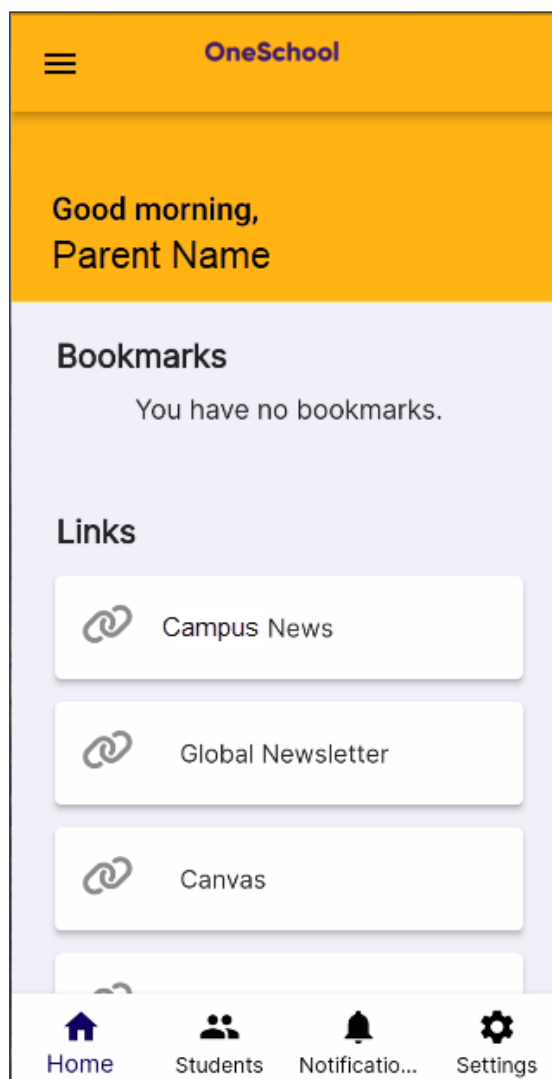
Follow these steps to setup your OnePortal mobile app using QR code.

- Open OnePortal in a Web browser
- Login to your OnePortal through the web browser and then go to your profile (top right corner).
- Open your OnePortal mobile app once installed and select the **“Scan QR Code”** button.
- From the web browser, select **“App qrcode”** to display the QR code and then scan the code with your PortalHQ mobile app. Note that a QR code only lasts 3 minutes before you need to refresh and get a new one to scan.
- Your OnePortal mobile app will now be logged in.



OnePortal App Dashboard

- Navigation through the App is intuitive. The home screen allows access to campus news, Canvas, Engage and other key items through the “Links” options.
- To access your child(ren)’s specific details including their information, Canvas and Engage, select the “Students” button at the bottom of the screen
- You can customise your notifications and other settings through the respective button also at the bottom of the screen.

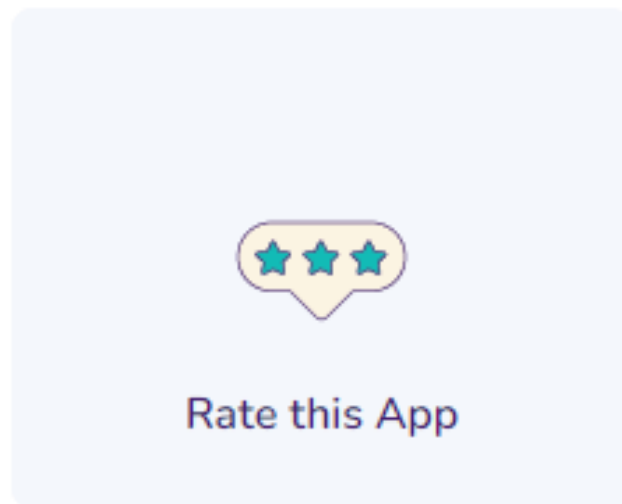
